2005.

Under cover of a letter from you dated December 2, 2005, (see reference above) SCE&G received a Demand for Information pertaining to the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station. Pursuant to your letter, we are required to file an answer, under oath or affirmation, within thirty-five days; i.e., on or before January 6, 2006.

Developing responses to the Demand for Information will require the collection of information from, and verification by, numerous sources. This, coupled with the intervening holidays, will make compliance with the schedule extremely difficult. Accordingly, we request an additional two weeks within which to respond; i.e., to January 20, 2006. Granting the extension of time will not delay the substantive adoption of strategies and, therefore, have no adverse impact on safety. In addition, efforts directed at identifying additional strategies under ongoing Phase 3 activities will not be affected.
