PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee has three facilities authorized on the license. The Summersville, WV facility is located in the Medical office building near Summersville Hospital with the camera room and the hot lab in Suite 203 and the treadmill room on the fourth floor. The inspector observed procedures used to perform injections on the patient wards of Summersville Hospital. Operations are conducted from Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. The full range of diagnostic studies are performed. Six to eight studies per day are performed. Two nuclear medicine technologists are on staff. An authorized user is either at the facility or in Summersville Hospital. The Bremono Road, Richmond, VA and Hi Oaks, Richmond, VA facilities consist of a camera room, hot laboratory and a separate treadmill area. The three nuclear medicine technologists rotate between the two facilities. Only cardiology studies are performed at the facilities with five or six being performed at Bremono Road and seven to nine at Hi Oaks. Operations are conducted Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. at Bremono Road and 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Hi Oaks. Authorized users are on-site or at the nearby hospitals at each facility. All facilities receive unit doses from a licensed radiopharmacy. The licensee will be submitting a notification regarding changes in the facilities and an update of the list of authorized users.
