SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF DECEMBER 15, 2005, MEETING WITH HOLTEC ON

TRANSPORTATION OF HUMBOLT BAY STORAGE CASKS

On December 15, 2005, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and Holtec International held a pre-application meeting to discuss Holtec's plan regarding the submittal of an application for transporting Humbolt Bay storage casks. The application would be in the form of a request for amending HI-STAR 100 transport Certificate of Compliance (CoC) in order to include HI-STAR 100 Humbolt Bay package design.

Holtec outlined the additional analyses needed in the Safety Analysis Report (SAR) for each of the technical areas. Furthermore, Holtec presented a list of changes which they are planing to include in the amendment request as generic changes. The additional analyses for the Humbolt Bay package design will be included as supplements in each of the SAR chapters. Holtec is planning to submit the amendment request in the first half of 2006. The fabrication of the casks are scheduled to begin in January 2006.

No regulatory decisions were made at the meeting.
