This is a follow-up to your earlier e-mail to Dr. Jankovich (see below) to authorize International Isotopes to distribute sources containing both byproduct and NARM material.

In light of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 giving authority to the NRC for the regulation of NARM, our intent is to add the NARM material to the current SSD certificate NR-1235-S-102-S. We would like to accept the review performed by the State of Texas for the NARM under the former SSD certificate TX-1153-S-102-S, as the basis for adding the NARM to the NRC certificate. Therefore, we would appreciate it if you could send us a copy of your SSD file/background information for International Isotopes so that we could include it in our records. On the Sealed Source and Device Evaluation #NR-1235-S-102-S which supercedes #TX-1153-S-102-S only the byproduct materials were included on the new NRC Registration Certificate. Please confirm that this is not an oversight. I understand the NRC does not normally issue certificates that cover non-byproduct material but discussion with other licensing staff here in Texas would indicate that non-byproduct materials have been included on registration certificates in the past along with the byproduct materials.
