Enclosed is Amendment No. 32 to your NRC Material License No. 13-18879-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. This amendment incorporates several updates and changes from revised 10 CFR Part 35, including the deletion of Condition Nos. 16 through 20, as they appeared on Amendment No. 31. These Conditions are no longer necessary because HDR brachytherapy is covered by 10 CFR 35.600 - 35.690 now. As a result, several Conditions and authorizations were *deleted and/or modified and/or re-ordered*. Please also be reminded of the notification requirements in 10 CFR 35.14.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
