This letter is in response to your email requesting clarification about whether our facility possesses or possessed a Co-60 sealed source. As discussed during our telephone conversation, Old Dominion University is no longer in possession of any Co60 sealed sources requiring licensing. At one time, the university did possess two 10mCi Co60 sealed sources (US Nuclear, Model J-687). Adco Service Inc. on April 18, 1991, Manifest No. 91-0523, picked-up the sources for disposal in the Barwell Radioactive Waste Facility. A record of this waste shipment is on file.
