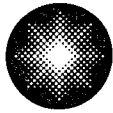


On October 14, 2003, Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant submitted a License Amendment Request (Reference a) that would have modified the current engineered safety features refueling surveillance interval requirement from once per refueling cycle to once every other refueling cycle on a staggered basis. Using a staggered basis interval, only one engineered safety feature train would be tested each refueling outage. This License Amendment Request is based on a Westinghouse Electric Company topical report (Reference b), and Technical Specification Task Force-450.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Staff has raised issues during the review of the topical report that has extended the review period and may require changes to that report and to the associated plant-specific license amendment. Accordingly, Calvert Cliffs hereby withdraws the referenced License Amendment Request (Reference a) from NRC review. No further action should be taken on this License Amendment Request. Calvert Cliffs currently plans to re-submit a similar License Amendment Request following resolution of the NRC Staff issues.




