In letter dated October 12, 2005 and an NRC Form 314 dated November 22, 2005, Dr. Breece contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that he wished to terminate his NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. The facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-26491-01 is hereby terminated.
