Please note, based upon the close-out survey results in the letter dated August 31, 2005, we have authorized the release of the scan room at St. John's Breech Medical Center, 100 Hospital Drive, Lebanon, Missouri, and the hot laboratory at Physicians Office Building, 120 Hospital Circle, Suite 100, Lebanon, Missouri, for unrestricted use.

Also note, we have added a license condition that limits your possession of byproduct materials to quantities that do not require decommissioning financial assurance.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
