Dear Kay,

George France of the Region III staff asked me to provide you with some information on the Combustion Engineering fuel processing facility in Hematite, Missouri.

On June 16, 1989, the facility was authorized to possess and use uranium enriched to a maximum of 5 percent with the isotope uranium-235. A copy of the authorization letter is enclosed. The previous enrichment limit was 4.1 percent, according to the licenses current since 1977. (Earlier licenses are no longer available in the Region III files, but have been placed in long term storage.)

The company has requested authorization to operate additional uranium pellet production facilities at the Hematite plant, transferring pellet production from its Windsor Connecticut, plant. Copies of the Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact are enclosed.

If I can be of further assistance, please let me know.
