Dear Ms. Jarriel:

Prior to the session on safety culture at the Regulatory Information Conference last month, you asked me if it would be okay if the response to my letter to the Commission protesting the NRC's unexcused foot-dragging in their disposal of the allegations by Dr. Harvin of retaliation could wait until after the agency decided that case. You told me the decision would be made by the end of March.
