Re: Transfer of NRC Materials License No. 47-19784-for Level Bin Indicators.

In accordance with 10 CFR 31.5(c)(9)(i) this letter is to inform the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that Elkem Metals Company - Alloy, L.P. ("Elkem") as of December 21, 2005, will sell its manufacturing facilities on U.S. 60 East Alloy, West Virginia (P.O. Box 613, Alloy, West Virginia 25002-0613) to West Virginia Alloys, Inc. ("WV Alloys"), U.S. 60 East Alloy, West Virginia (P.O. Box 613, Alloy, West Virginia 25002-0613) and request that the Materials License No. 47-19784-01 ("Materials License") for:

- A. Use of Cesium 137 in sealed sources contained in compatible non-portable gauging devices (registered pursuant to 10 CFR 32.210 and distributed in accordance with an NRC or Agreement State License) for measuring properties of materials and/or controlling industrial processes.
- B. Use of Cesium 137, not to exceed 200 millicuries per source, in Nuclear-Chicago Model 5192 source holders for level measurements.

be transferred to WV Alloys as licensee as of noon on December 21, 2005.

Elkem, as transferor of the Materials License, has provided to WV Alloys as transferee, a copy of 10 CFR 19, 10 CFR 20 10 CFR 30, 10 CFR 31 and any safety documents identified in the label of the devices. The individual who may constitute a point of contact between the NRC and the transferee is:
