Subject: Restoration Injection Fluid Release

Steve and Paul,

Please consider this formal notification that PRI had a reportable release of restoration injection fluid at injection well CI-140 in the C-Wellfield at the Smith Ranch-Highland Uranium Project. The release was detected at approximately 12:30 am on Friday December 30, 2005 by a Satellite Operator. The release resulted from a broken well casing at ground level.

Approximately 1000 gallons of restoration injection fluid was released. Since the release was restoration fluid it contained a uranium concentration of approximately 0.7 mg/L, which is less than typical production injection fluid. The release did not enter Waters of the State. Approximately 2000 gallons of released fluid was recovered.

A written report will be submitted within 7 days.
