Subject: Phone call discussion with USEC on radiation protection

Brian,

This afternoon, Mike LaMastra and I discussed 8 radiation protection items with Pete Miner, Dave Couser and Jim Thomas of USEC. During the call for each of these items USEC indicated that it would:

1. either provide additional information or commit to ANSI 3.1 concerning HP tech training
2. make Table 4.6-1 of the LA consistent with our Branch Technical Position on surface contamination criteria by revising the 500 dpm/100 cm² criterion to 200 dpm/100 cm² for transuranics above 8% and several other radionuclides
3. commit to the reporting criteria contained in 10 CFR 30.50 and 10 CFR 4.60
4. commit to the RG on summation of internal and external doses
5. commit to maintaining training records on use of respiratory equipment
6. commit to the appropriate Reg Guide concerning the mechanics of air sampling
7. add words affirming that reports made under part 20 or 70.24 will be referred to its corrective action program for review
8. commit to the appropriate Reg Guide concerning the maintenance of radiation protection records

USEC committed to incorporating these changes in its next large revision which it is planning to submit to the NRC in mid-February.
