This letter is in reference to the request dated November 23, 2005 to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission license 37-01321-02. Please provide the following information:

1. In accordance with 10 CFR 35.50, please provide evidence showing Ms. Bookser has completed a structured educational program consisting of 200 hours of classroom and laboratory training in the following areas:

- a. Radiation physics and instrumentation
- b. Radiation protection
- c. Mathematics pertaining to the use and measurement of radioactivity
- d. Radiation biology
- e. Radiation dosimetry

2. Please provide evidence of **one year of full time radiation experience** under the supervision of **the individual identified as the Radiation Safety Officer** on a Commission or Agreement State license that authorizes **similar types of uses of byproduct material** involving the following:

- a. Shipping, receiving, and performing related radiation surveys
- b. Using and performing checks for proper operation of instruments used to determine the activity of dosages, survey meters, and instruments used to measure radionuclides
- c. Securing and controlling byproduct material
- d. Using administrative controls to avoid mistakes in the administration of byproduct material
- e. Using procedures to prevent or minimize radioactive contamination and using proper decontamination procedures
- f. Using emergency procedures to control byproduct material
- g. Disposing of byproduct material

3. Please provide evidence that Ms. Bookser has had training in radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the types of use listed on Mercy Hospital's license. This requirement may be met through training under the supervision of an individual as listed in 10 CFR 35.50 (e)

4. Please provide written attestation, signed by a preceptor Radiation Safety Officer, that Ms. Bookser has completed the requirements of items 1, 2, and 3 above, and that she has achieved a level of radiation safety knowledge to function independently as a Radiation Safety Officer

As stated previously, you must provide this information within 30 days. You may fax your response to 610-337-5269, referencing mail control 138037. Please notify me when the fax is sent so I will know to look for it. You may e-mail or call me with any questions.
