Dear Dr. Arnold:

This is in reference to your letter dated December 2, 2005 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-28333-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have requested the removal of facility at 310 Chris Gaupp Road, Galloway Twp. N.J. from your license. As required in the guidance published in NUREG-1757, Volume 1, Revision 1, "Decommissioning Process for Materials Licensees," provide the following information:
  - a. Confirm that all activities authorized by the license has ceased at this location, the date it ceased, and how the all the licensed materials procured and or possessed at the facility have been disposed. For transfers, specify the date of the transfer, the name of the licensed recipient, and the recipients' NRC license number or Agreement State name and license number. If materials were disposed of directly by the licensee rather than transferred to another licensee, licensed disposal site or waste contractor, describe the specific disposal procedures (e.g. decay in storage). For transfers to other than your new site, please provide confirmation of transfer.
  - b. For all sealed sources that were used or stored at the facility, including those no longer in licensee's possession, provide the results from the most recent leak tests.
  - c. Transfer the decommissioning records discussed in 10 CFR 30.35, 30.36, and 30.51 as appropriate or confirm that no records were required for this facility.

2. You have requested Dr. Ahmend to be an authorized user. In support of this authorization please provide the following information:
  - a. Provide documentation that the preceptor, Dr. Michael Joh, is an authorized user on NRC license 21-03210-01. This license type does not specifically list authorized user. A letter from the Radiation Safety Officer stating that Dr. Michael Joh is an authorized user for 10 CFR 35.200 materials is recommended.
  - b. There appears to be no attestation statement from an authorized preceptor that Dr. Sujood Ahmed performed the classroom and laboratory training as written on the Form 313M Supplement A supplied with your amendment request. This is requirement is outlined by 10 CFR 35.290 (c)(2). Please provide a written attestation, signed by a preceptor authorized user for this portion of the training. Provide documentation that the preceptor that attests this training is an authorized user on an NRC or Agreement State License.
  
3. You have requested Dr. David Kann to be an authorized user. In support of this authorization please provide the following information:
  - a. Provide indication that the Dr. David Kann has completed all the work experience as outlined in 10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii). Please provide the details of experience as required by . It is recommend that NRC form 313A is used to document this experience.
  - b. There appears to be no attestation statement from an authorized preceptor that Dr. David Kann performed the classroom and laboratory training as written on the certificate by the Consultants in Nuclear Medicine supplied with your amendment request. This requirement is outline by 10 CFR 35.290 (c)(2). Please provide a written attestation, signed by a preceptor authorized user for this portion of the training. Provide documentation that the preceptor that attests this training is an authorized user on an NRC or Agreement State License.
