Dear Mr. Roberts:

As we discussed on November 12, 1999 CBS Corporation has completed the building demolition at the above-referenced facility. Beginning December 6, 1999, CBS intends to begin the removal of the impacted storm sewer pipe and Building 7 basement soils. The objective of this removal action is to allow unrestricted release of the property. CBS will use the existing site-specific criteria for unrestricted release. Based upon current data it is anticipated that the work will be completed before February 28, 2000.

Because of safety concerns, excavations will be backfilled as soon as we collect the data necessary to document that impacted material has been removed. If the Nuclear Regulatory Commission identifies an area(s) that they would like to observe or survey, we can provide notification prior to backfilling. Please contact me if you identify an area of interest.

Our activities are being coordinated with Bloomfield Township officials to allow a timely and safe completion of this work. New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection representatives are also aware of the upcoming remediation.

In closing, CBS appreciates your continuing efforts to assist us in resolving the remaining issues at the facility. Please call me if you have questions on any aspect of the upcoming remediation.
