- 1. Radiation Physics and Instrumentation
- 2. Radiation Protection
- 3. Mathematics pertaining to the use and measurement of radioactivity.
- 4. Chemistry of byproduct material for medical use.
- 5. Radiation Biology

Michael Escano, M.D. participated in nuclear cardiac rotations during his cardiology fellowship at the Medical University of South Carolina and at the VA Medical Center in Charleston. He rotated April 1 – July 2, 2003, December 1 until December 31, 2003. He thus completed 800 hours of clinical training in nuclear cardiology.
