SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR OFFICE AND REGIONAL COMMENTS ON THE
DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY'S PROPOSED
PROTECTIVE ACTIONS GUIDES FOR RADIOLOGICAL DISPERSAL
DEVICE AND IMPROVISED NUCLEAR DEVICE INCIDENTS

Your review and suggested revisions are requested on the enclosed Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Protective Action Guides (PAGs) for Radiological Dispersal Device (RDD) and Improvised Nuclear Device (IND) Incidents. As you are aware, DHS has issued these PAGs, which are primarily based on the 1992 Environmental Protective Agency's (EPA's) "Manual of PAGs and Protective Actions for Nuclear Incidents," for recommending guidelines and protective actions to support decisions that may need to be taken to protect the public when responding to, or recovering from, an RDD or IND incident.

In order to provide time for coordination of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission comments with the Office of the Executive Director for Operations and the Commission before forwarding to DHS, we are requesting that all office and regional comments be provided no later than February 15, 2006.
