In any decisions with respect to the Design Basis Threat of nuclear power plants, it is essential that plants be able to repel an attack of at least as great as the 17 corrdinated terrorists working in 4 groups that attacked on 9/11/01. In addition, basic security at plants need to include beamhenge protection. Also, dry cask storage must be protected through separation (50 yeard minimum spacing between each cask), beamheng, and burial in earthen mounds.
