Dear Secretary, Rulemakings and Adjudications, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission,

I am a physician with training in Nuclear Medicine and a long history of concern about environmental toxins and their impact on our health. I am writing because of my serious concerns regarding the failure of the NRC to improve the security of our nuclear plants.

The NRC proposal to make zero upgrades to existing security requirements for nuclear facilities is unacceptable given today's climate of terrorism. Congress charged the NRC to include consideration for 9/11-level threats when developing policy yet this rulemaking fails to comply with this order. Current security measures could not withstand neither an attack by air, nor an attack by a large group of attackers.

The NRC proposal provides nothing but vague generalities making genuine public comment impossible and reducing any confidence the public may have had in the NRC. Hence, I am in support of the Committee to Bridge the Gap Petition for Rulemaking to upgrade reactor security, including suggestions such as the construction of "Beamhenge" shields for additional protection from air-based threats.
