SUBJECT: RESCISSION OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR SENSITIVE  
INFORMATION SCREENING PROJECT REVIEWS OF  
EXTERNALLY ORIGINATED DOCUMENTS

The purpose of this memorandum is to rescind the requirement for the Sensitive Information Screening Project (SISP) review of externally originated documents.

In a memorandum dated October 26, 2005, I implemented new policy and procedures for handling, marking, and protecting sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information (SUNSI) and issued a communication plan outlining the significant changes in policy. One significant change eliminated the requirement for the SISP review of *internally* originated documents. The requirement for a SISP review for *externally* originated documents remained in place.

Later in the year, NRC published two regulatory issue summaries (RIS) to external NRC stakeholders clarifying the expectations for protecting SUNSI:

- (a) RIS 2005-26, "Control of Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information Related to Nuclear Power Reactors," dated November 7, 2005, and
- (b) RIS 2005-31, "Control of Security-Related Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information Handled by Individuals, Firms, and Entities Subject to NRC Regulation of the Use of Source, Byproduct, and Special Nuclear Material," dated December 22, 2005.

In addition, the Offices of New Reactors, Nuclear Reactor Regulation, Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, and Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs implemented procedures to ensure externally originated documents receive an appropriate SUNSI review. Implementation of these office procedures, along with external stakeholder implementation of the above RIS' will help ensure that SUNSI will be properly protected.
