**DOMINION RESOURCES SERVICES, INC. FOR**  
**NORTH ANNA POWER STATION UNITS 1 & 2**  
**SURRY POWER STATION UNITS 1 & 2**  
**MILLSTONE POWER STATION UNITS 1, 2, & 3**  
**KEWAUNEE POWER STATION UNIT 1**  
**CONSOLIDATION OF QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM APPROVALS FOR**  
**RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL PACKAGES NOS. 0194, 0207, AND 0362**

North Anna and Surry Power Stations (licensee Virginia Electric and Power Company), Millstone Power Station (licensee Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc.) and Kewaunee Power Station (licensee Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc.) currently have three active 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approvals for Radioactive Material Packages (NRC Form 311). The purpose of this correspondence is to request that the three current program approvals (0194 for North Anna and Surry, 0207 for Millstone, and 0362 for Kewaunee) be combined into one; an action that will reduce the administrative burden for both the NRC and these three licensees, collectively referred to as Dominion.

Specifically, Dominion requests that Millstone Power Station be added to North Anna and Surry Power Station's Program Approval 0194. This may be accomplished by adding "Millstone Power Station, Units 1, 2, and 3" to Section 6, Conditions. Additionally, Program Approval 0194's Section 2, Name, should be changed from "Virginia Electric and Power Company" to "Dominion Resources Services, Inc.". The remainder of Section 2 (i.e., the address) remains unchanged. This change would place the program approved for North Anna, Surry and Millstone Power Stations under the support services company name, facilitate the inclusion of Kewaunee Power Station (discussed below), and permit Program Approval 0194 to accept, if needed, future Dominion fleet additions. Program Approval 0207 could then be cancelled.


Kewaunee Power Station's current Program Approval 0362 identifies "Nuclear Management Company, LLC. Kewaunee" (NMC) in Section 2, Name. However, the license transfer of Kewaunee to Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc. (DEK) occurred on July 05, 2005. Kewaunee's approved site QA Program was modified using the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(a) to reflect the license transfer from NMC to DEK. Dominion requests that "Kewaunee Power Station" be added to Section 6, Conditions, on Program Approval 0194. Program Approval 0362 could then be cancelled.

Dominion notes that the expiration dates in Section 3 of Program Approvals 0194 and 0207 are currently July 30, 2015 and that the expiration date in Program Approval 0362 is March 31, 2015. Dominion recommends that the current expiration date on Program Approval 0194 be maintained following incorporation of the proposed changes.

With respect to the Program Approval consolidation requested above, Dominion notes that all Dominion sites covered by the above discussions continue to function under approved 10 CFR Part 50 Quality Assurance Programs. Dominion is currently in the process of implementing a fleet Quality Assurance Program based on NQA-1-1994 across all of its sites. This program, DOM-QA-1-A, was approved by the NRC on September 9, 2005, and is currently scheduled to be implemented fleet-wide by June 30, 2006.
