Enclosed is Amendment No. 04 to your NRC Material License No. 34-29200-01MD in accordance with your request. Please note that changes made to your license, including updates to License Condition No. 14, leak test, which are printed in **bold** font.

Please note that we have not authorized Cami O'Connor and Vai Paye as Authorized Users as requested. As discussed in a telephone conversation on January 9, 2006, between David Breuning and myself, we need you to provide additional information on the actual use of radioisotopes both individuals. Note that the Authorized User must demonstrate training and experience with the types and quantities of material that is to be used at the pharmacy. As discussed, their training and experience can be described using a format similar to Figure G-2 in Appendix G, NUREG 1556, Vol. 13, "Program-Specific Guidance About Commercial Radiopharmacy Licenses."

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
