The material included the Americium-241 and Cesium-137 sources. They have records for the results of leak tests for all of the sources and certification of the sources being received by Los Alamos. The licensee will be starting a project in Texas and wanted to know if the licensee could renew its license. I stated that the licensee would have to transfer the sources between the Texas site and the West Virginia location since possessing the sources for greater than six months in Texas would require a state license. Otherwise, a reciprocity request would need to be made to the State of Texas for their activities under the NRC license.
