As required by 10 CFR 74.17(a) and the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP), the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) is submitting to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), the SNM and SM Physical Inventory Summary Report for the Portsmouth, Ohio, Gaseous Diffusion Plant. The Form 327 covers the inventory period October 1, 2005 through November 30, 2005. This inventory was taken at 1400 hours on November 30, 2005.

- Enclosure 1 includes inventory data for the Portsmouth plant.
- Enclosure 2 provides additional notes regarding the inventory data.

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain information concerning USEC's material control and accounting program for special nuclear material at the plant. As such, Enclosures 1 and 2 contain confidential commercial or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Section 1314 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4), 2.390(d)(1) and 9.17(a)(4). USEC hereby requests that Enclosures 1 and 2 be withheld from public disclosure based on 10 CFR 2.390(d), which states, in part:

The following information shall be deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 9.17(a)(4) of this chapter and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 9.19 of this chapter.

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(1) Correspondence and reports to or from the NRC which contain information or records concerning a licensee's or applicant's physical protection or material control and accounting program for special nuclear material not otherwise designated as Safeguards Information or classified as National Security Information or Restricted Data.
