DESIGN BASIS THREAT; EXTENDED PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD (STP-06-009)

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has extended its public comment period on Design Basis Threat (DBT)) from January 23, 2006, to February 22, 2006. This extension was published on January 24, 2006 in the *Federal Register* (71 FR 3791) and can be accessed at http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/. The proposed rule originally published on November 7, 2005 (70 FR 67380) would amend the Commission's regulations to, among other things, make generically applicable the security requirements previously imposed by the Commission's April 29, 2003 DBT orders, which applied to existing licensees, and redefine the level of security requirements necessary to ensure that the public health and safety and common defense and security are adequately protected.
