Application for Indirect Transfers of Control - Additional Information

This is a follow-up letter to the application filed by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC, and FPL Energy Duane Arnold, LLC on January 20, 2006 (L-2006-011), regarding the proposed indirect transfers of control of the Turkey Point Nuclear Plant, Units 3 and 4 operating licenses (DPR-31, DPR-41), the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 operating licenses (DPR-67, NPF-16), the Seabrook Station operating license (NPF-86), and the Duane Arnold Energy Center (DAEC) operating license (DPR-49) that will occur as a result of the merger between FPL Group, Inc. and Constellation Energy Group, Inc. ("Constellation Energy").

The January 20, 2006 application requested NRC consent to the indirect transfer of control over interests in the DAEC license that FPL Energy Duane Arnold anticipated it would have following the closing of a pending acquisition. Please be advised that on January 27, 2006, FPL Energy Duane Arnold closed on its acquisition of a 70% ownership interest in DAEC. FPL Energy Duane Arnold is now a licensed owner and the licensed operator of DAEC. Accordingly, FPL Energy Duane Arnold affirms that it is seeking the NRC's consent to the indirect transfer of control over FPL Energy Duane Arnold's existing interests in the DAEC operating license.
