Mr. Johns was advised that the NRC had reviewed the former licensee's survey data and made the determination that the areas adjoining the former site meet the NRC's unrestricted release criteria, and that they NRC would not pursue this issue any further. Mr. Johns was advised that he would receive a copy of the letter.
