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2) Physical Description

This shipment will consist of 217 boxes of Depleted Uranium in 12x 20' ocean containers. The total weight of the shipment is 138831.3 kgs. of uranium.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel will sail from Le Havre, France on July 18, 2002. The ocean transportation from Le Havre, France to Montreal, Quebec, Canada will be the responsibility of Canada Maritime Steamship Line. The vessel will unload at Montreal, Quebec, Canada on or about July 25, 2002. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Port Huron, MI. The containers will enter the USA at Port Huron, MI on or about August 2, 2002, and will continue on rail to customer siding in Clive, Utah.


