
As we discussed by phone on this date, there are several changes we request in the subject license as it is being amended at the present time to reflect the transfer from Olin Corp. to Clearon Corp. which was initiated by Clearon Corp. letter of March 19, 1996, "Notification of Transfer of Ownership Olin Corporation License Number 47-24837-01" and a letter from Olin Corporation dated March 15, 1996 on the same subject.

In addition to the name change we are additionally requesting the following amendments:

1. The Radiation Safety Officer for the license should be Roger D. Droddy who had been listed as the Alternate Radiation Safety Officer. Mr. Droddy completed the Ohmart Radiation Safety Training Course, Cincinnati, Ohio, February 4-7, 1992. A copy of the certificate of completion is attached. Mr. R. L Daniels can be deleted from the license. Mr. Droddy should be listed in item 12: "Licensed material shall shall be used by, or under the supervision of, R. D. Droddy.
2. Item 14 covers installation, relocation and removal from service of devices. It is our intent to utilize Mr. Droddy to perform such services in addition to Ohmart or Kay-Ray. Mr. Droddy's training from Ohmart included these tasks and installation, removal and relocation are identified on the certificate.
