In letter no. 102-05403, dated January 25, 2006, Arizona Public Service Company (APS) registered the use of dry spent fuel storage cask transportable storage canister (TSC) identification no. AMZDFX035, used to store spent fuel within vertical concrete cask (VCC) no. AMZDNE035 beginning on January 27, 2006. On page two of the January 25, 2006 submittal the applicable reactor was identified as Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station Unit 3. The reactor should have been identified as Unit 2 instead of Unit 3. The reactor license and docket numbers listed in the January 25, 2006 submittal correctly reflect the PVNGS Unit 2 license and docket numbers.
