The ExxonMobil Billings Refinery is submitting this letter as a request to amend Materials License No. SUB 1382. A new Radiation Safety Officer, Mr. Stanley Jakob Clapham is replacing the previous RSO, Mr. David A. Newburn. The desired effective date for this change was December 19, 2005. A notice was sent to the NRC on November 22, 2005 to inform the agency of the change and to request an amendment to the refinery's active license (Materials License Number 25-03375-01).

This license SUB 1382 is inactive, and we are in the process of decommissioning it. Our Decommissioning Plan is being reviewed by Mr. Robert Evans, NRC Region IV, Fuel Cycle Decommissioning Branch. ExxonMobil has hired Weston Solutions to provide D&D support. We hope to have the license terminated within the next 30-60 days.

Mr. Clapham has received training that meets the NRC standard for qualification to be listed on an NRC license and have been listed as an RSO on a license in a previous position; supporting documentation is enclosed. 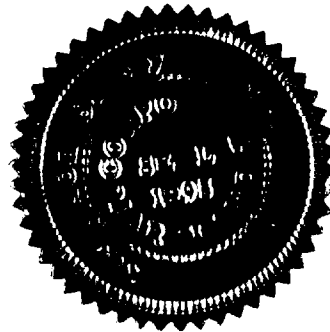

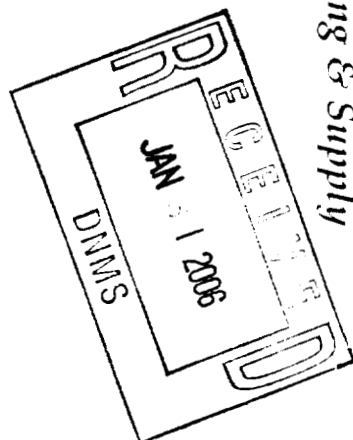
