**SUBJECT: WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY, LLC - HEMATITE, AMENDMENT 42
(TAC NO. L31556) TO CHANGE THE SCOPE OF LICENSED ACTIVITIES TO
THE PERFORMANCE OF DECOMMISSIONING ACTIVITIES**

Dear Mr. Nardi:

In accordance with your application dated September 11, 2001, and pursuant to Part 70 to Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Materials License SNM-33 is hereby amended to reduce the possession limits for source and special nuclear material and to change the scope of authorized activities to the performance of decommissioning activities. Accordingly, Safety Condition S-1 has been revised to include the date of September 11, 2001. In addition, new Safety Conditions S-8 and S-9 have been added and read as follows:

- S-8 The licensee shall not perform the following activities until they are approved by specific license amendment or an NRC-approved Decommissioning Plan:
- Building demolition
 - Soil and groundwater remediation
 - Final status surveys
- S-9 The licensee shall submit a Decommissioning Plan for NRC approval by April 30, 2004, in accordance with the Schedule for Submission of Hematite Decommissioning Plan proposed by Westinghouse letter dated October 30, 2000, and accepted by NRC letter dated May 30, 2001.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

Enclosed are copies of the revised Materials License SNM-33 and the Safety Evaluation Report, which includes the Categorical Exclusion.


