Mr. Courtemanche:

In accordance with the guidance in NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Section 5, Richard Barry Marketing Group (RBMG) is notifying the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a pending change in ownership. Mr. Richard Timbo, Principal, listed in the materials license Condition 11, will be transferring his stocks in RBMG to another individual. This transaction is currently scheduled to take place on or about February 28, 2006.

This business transaction should not constitute any changes to the conditions or incorporated documents in either license at this time. I, Richard J. Timbo, will remain in my current capacity as stated in Condition 11 and the licensee's name will remain unchanged beyond the date of the transfer of stocks. No changes are being made with respect to the requirements in 10 CFR 32.22. At any point in the future when any such license conditions are desired to be changed by the licensee, the licensee will submit an appropriate license amendment request using the guidance in NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Section 5.

The licensee considers this to be a business transaction that does not affect any licensed activities. Furthermore, there will be no change or reduction in the effectiveness of the radiation safety program. The Radiation Safety Officer, Michael S. Brightwell, is fully aware of this pending business transaction and continues to be involved from a licensed program standpoint.

It is our request that the NRC acknowledge this business transaction prior to scheduled date to allow business to continue uninterrupted. This notification serves as my guarantee that I will continue to serve in my current licensed capacity until any future changes are submitted in future amendments and approved by the NRC.


