JOINT STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING INITIAL DISCLOSURES

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2006, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") issued an order granting the request of petitioner Concerned Citizens of Honolulu ("Concerned Citizens") for a hearing on the application submitted by Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC ("Applicant") to build and operate a commercial pool-type industrial irradiator at the Honolulu International Airport;

WHEREAS, the Board's January 24, 2006 order admitted for hearing Concerned Citizens' first environmental contention and the first portion of Concerned Citizens' second environmental contention;

WHEREAS, the Board has not yet ruled on the admissibility of Concerned Citizens' contentions regarding safety;

WHEREAS, the Board's granting of Concerned Citizens' hearing request triggered the thirty (30)-day period for the Parties to make disclosures pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(a) and (b) and 10 C.F.R. § 2.1203(a); and


WHEREAS, Concerned Citizens, the Applicant, and the NRC Staff (collectively, "the Parties") believe it would promote the efficient and expeditious resolution of these proceedings

if, prior to preparing their disclosures, the Parties knew the full scope of the issues admitted for hearing;

NOW THEREFORE, it is stipulated and agreed to by the Parties as follows:

The Parties shall have thirty (30) days from the issuance of the Board's order regarding the admissibility of Concerned Citizens' remaining contentions to make the disclosures required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(a) and (b) and 10 C.F.R. § 2.1203(a).

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

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
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
