
I am very strongly opposed to the 3 proposals that
Entergy Corporation has pending before the Nuclear
Regulatory Commission for the Vermont Yankee
Nuclear Power Plant in Vernon, VT.

3. an expansion of their high-level waste storage capacity.

fear for our safety and that of our community if approval is
given to Entergy Corporation. This plant is an antique
