SUBJECT: Retraction of License Amendment Request (LAR), "Change to Diesel Generator Surveillance Testing"

On February 6, 2006, the Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) held a teleconference with Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) personnel to discuss the Reference 2 License Amendment Request (LAR) proposing a change to surveillance testing of the Fort Calhoun Station emergency diesel generators (EDGs). The LAR was submitted to support installation of a proposed modification (EC 33661) to the EDG starting circuitry.


As a result of the teleconference, OPPD is re-evaluating Modification EC 33661 and will not require a license amendment at this time. Therefore, OPPD hereby withdraws the Reference 2 License Amendment Request.
