Reference: Nuclear Regulatory Commission Generic Letter 2006-01, "Steam Generator Tube Integrity and Associated Technical Specifications," dated January 20, 2006.



This attachment provides Indiana Michigan Power Company's (I&M) response to Option 1 in the Requested Information section of Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Generic Letter (GL) 2006-01, which is restated below:

“Option 1: Within 30 days of the date of this GL, either confirm that you have submitted a request to modify the SG [steam generator] portion of your TS [technical specifications] that is consistent with TSTF [Technical Specification Task Force]-449, Revision 4, or provide a regulatory commitment detailing your plans and schedule for submitting such a request (refer to Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-17, “Managing Regulatory Commitments Made by Power Reactor Licensees to the NRC Staff”). If you modify your commitment so that the request will not be submitted by May 31, 2006, provide the information requested in Option 2 within 60 days of changing your commitment.

If your commitment is to submit a request after May 31, 2006, provide the information requested in Option 2. If you or the NRC staff determine that your submittal is not consistent with TSTF-449, Revision 4, provide the information requested in Option 2 within 60 days of this determination.”

I&M's Response

I&M will submit a request to modify the SG portion of TS consistent with TSTF generic change traveler TSTF-449, Revision 4 by May 31, 2006. Should I&M identify the need to modify the commitment date of May 31, 2006, information requested in Option 2 of the generic letter will be provided within 60 days of that determination.
