Subject: Submittal of Report Documenting the Radiological Status of the Westinghouse Specialty Metals Plant Site and Demonstrating Compliance with the Provisions of 10 CFR 20.1402 to Release the Site for Unrestricted Use

Reference: Terminated Licenses No. SNM-37 (Docket No. 070-00026) and SUC-509 (Docket No. 040-03558)

Dear Mr. Roberts:

The Westinghouse Electric Company LLC hereby submits the attached documentation to demonstrate compliance with 10 CFR 20.1402 for the Westinghouse Specialty Metals Plant located near Blairsville, PA. Although this facility is not currently licensed, previous operations were conducted under the two terminated licenses referenced above. The site was identified during the Oak Ridge review of previously terminated licenses as having insufficient records to assure the buildings and property meet the current criteria for unrestricted use.

Since 1993, Westinghouse has conducted radiological surveys at the site, along with some remediation. Such surveys and remediation were conducted in a manner that did not interfere with ongoing site operations and Westinghouse appreciates the cooperation of the Commission in allowing this extended time to complete the effort.

The DVD included with this submittal provides the information necessary to demonstrate that the site meets the provisions of 10 CFR 20.1402 to release the site for unrestricted use. For reference, a listing of all the files on the DVD is attached to this letter. All of the files are in Adobe PDF format and have been generated to meet the NRC standards for electron submittals.

Included in the documentation is the following:

1. A summary report has been prepared to consolidate the discussion of all survey and remediation activities that have occurred at the site. This report references all previous reports that have been submitted and includes links to the documents to ease the review process. Also included is documentation of the waste shipments that were made which demonstrate that the waste was properly disposed. The results of calculations using the RESRAD and RESRAD-Build codes are included to demonstrate that the remaining

residual levels of licensed material above natural background concentrations result in a radiation exposure that is well less than 25 mrem/yr.

2. For convenience, copies of all reports included in prior submittals to the NRC are included as attachments on the DVD. This provides a complete collection of reports related to the radiological remediation of the Blairsville site. These attached files were provided to the NRC in past years as they were generated in order to document progress made.

This submittal consolidates all applicable information and therefore replaces all information transmittals that were made in past years. A signed copy of Form NRC-314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" is attached.

Westinghouse requests that upon completion of the review of the attached documentation, the NRC document its concurrence that adequate information now exists to conclude that the site does meet the criteria specified in 10 CFR 20.1204 for unrestricted use. Concurrently Westinghouse understands that the Westinghouse Blairsville site will also be removed from the NRC listing of Complex sites.

In addition, the enclosed final status survey documentation demonstrates that the actual residual soil concentrations of licensed material do not exceed the soil concentrations values in Table 1 of the "Memorandum of Understanding between the Environmental Protection Agency and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission" (67FR65375). Consequently, Westinghouse understands that the NRC will not be required to consult with EPA regarding this site.
