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2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 25 x 48Y Cylinders loaded on one lash barge. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, non fissile or fissile-excepted. Total net weight of U is 205,000 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 1,450 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The surface transportation from Metropolis, IL to Paducah, KY will be the responsibility of TAM International Inc.
