SATISFACTORY FINDINGS:

Reviewed a total of 206 comments from 9 technical reports delivered between October 2005 and January 2006. Findings are as follows:

- Comments and author responses are clear, concise and appropriately documented.
- Approximately 9% of technical review comments and 18% of concurrence or programmatic review comments are resolved without change to the document.
- The highest concentration of comments are as expected, needed clarifications.

The review process appears to be effectively implemented. See page 2 for a summary of results.

Since reviewer comments related to editorial issues, definition of terms, and documentation of references, which are in most cases preventable, consider:

- 2. Performing a follow-up surveillance that includes staff interviews, to determine potential causes and identify process improvements and training opportunities.


