**JOINT REPORT REGARDING REDACTION OF
PROPRIETARY INFORMATION FROM FEBRUARY 2006 HEARING
TRANSCRIPT AND ASSOCIATED PROPRIETARY EXHIBITS**


This joint report is submitted on behalf of Louisiana Energy Services, L.P. ("LES"), Nuclear Information and Resource Service and Public Citizen ("NIRS/PC"), and the NRC Staff, and responds to the directive set forth in paragraph A.2 of the Licensing Board's February 16, 2006 Memorandum and Order (Post-Hearing Administrative Matters).¹ Specifically, the Board directed LES, NIRS/PC and the Staff to submit "a joint report outlining, at a minimum, the parties' proposal for dealing with the redaction of allegedly proprietary information from the transcript of the closed hearing sessions and associated proprietary exhibits."

To the best of LES's knowledge, the only information in the record warranting proprietary treatment is information that is proprietary to LES and/or third party commercial sources that supplied cost information to LES. LES is in the process of reviewing the hearing

transcript and associated party exhibits, and conferring with the other parties relative to certain proposed redactions. Accordingly, LES, with the concurrence of NIRS/PC and the NRC Staff, respectfully proposes to submit an additional joint report by the conclusion of business on Wednesday, March 1, 2006. That report will identify (1) the specific transcript redactions proposed by LES, (2) those exhibits (or portions thereof) which may be made publicly available, and (3) any potential disagreements among the parties with respect to the treatment of certain information or documents as proprietary.

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
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
