Background

- Bulletin 2005-02 was issued on July 18, 2005
 On licensee actions to address the post-9/11 environment
 - Strictly voluntary to incorporate any enhancements
 - Did not change regulations
 - Did not impose new requirements
- Licensees were requested to provide information on 5 onsite program areas:
 - Security-Based Emergency Classification Levels (ECL) and Emergency Action Levels (EAL)
 - Accelerated Notifications to NRC
 - Onsite Protective Actions
 - Emergency Response Organization (ERO) Augmentation
 - Security-Based Event Inclusion to Drills and Exercises
