MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Status of Mandatory Hearing-Related Document)

It has come to the Licensing Board's attention that NRC Staff Exh. 50-M, which was admitted in connection with the March 6, 2006 mandatory hearing in this proceeding, contains information that may be proprietary to applicant Louisiana Energy Services, L.P., (LES) and, as such, should be treated in accordance with the terms of the Board's May 21, 2004 protective order. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Protective Order Governing Disclosure of Protected Materials) (May 21, 2004) (unpublished). Accordingly, the staff and LES should confer and, on or before Friday, March 24, 2006, provide the Board with a redacted version of Staff Exh. 50-M, suitable for public disclosure.¹

In addition, the staff and LES should review the March 6, 2006 transcript of the mandatory hearing, including any written testimony bound into that transcript, to ensure that it

¹ In redacting that document, the parties should utilize a "blackout" method of redaction rather than a "whiteout" method, so that it is apparent to the reader where protected information has been removed from the document. In addition, for the redacted version, the parties should strike through any headers/footers or other page markings that previously indicated the existence of proprietary/protected information.

does not contain any reference to proprietary or otherwise protected information. In this regard, the parties should notify the Board and the Office of the Secretary immediately if that transcript contains any proprietary/protected information so that it is not made publically available and, if the transcript does contain any such information, the staff or LES should provide a list of proposed transcript redactions to the Board on or before Friday, March 24, 2006.
