Dear Mr. Michlig:

This refers to your March 1, 2006, letter providing a written report in accordance with 10 CFR 20.2201 regarding the theft of a Troxler portable gauge (Serial No. 36172). Your letter indicated that the gauge was stolen from the licensee's job trailer in Novi, Michigan, between February 4 and 6, 2006. The report described your search efforts, including coordination with local authorities and the gauge manufacturer, which, as of March 1, 2006, have not resulted in the recovery of the gauge.

We have reviewed your report of this theft, recovery efforts, and corrective actions and have no further questions at this time. Accordingly, no response to this letter is required. However, we do request that if the gauge is recovered, you notify the NRC Region III staff as soon as possible. The theft of the gauge will be examined during a future inspection.
