Dear Mrs. Korsnick:

Enclosed is a copy of the Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact related to your application dated July 7, 2005, as supplemented on August 15, September 30, December 6, 9, and 22, 2005, and January 11 and 25, and February 16 and March 3, 2006, for the R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant. The proposed amendment would authorize increasing the maximum steady-state reactor core power level from 1520 megawatts thermal (MWt) to 1775 MWt, which is an increase of approximately 16.8 percent. The proposed increase in power level is considered an extended power uprate.

The assessment is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication. In this regard, the comment period will expire on May 12, 2006.
