Dear Dr. Mascarenhas:

This is in reference to your letter dated February 6, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-30622-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your application should have been signed by a management representative rather than Anna K. Kinney, CNMT. Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
2. In support of your request to authorize Dr. Narpinder Singh for materials permitted under 10 CFR 35.100 & 35.200, please provide one of the following, as applicable:
  - a. Written certification, signed by a preceptor physician authorized user, that the training and experience as described in 10 CFR 35.290 has been satisfactorily completed;
  - b. If applicable, description of recent related continuing education and experience as required by 10 CFR 35.59; and
  - c. A copy of the license issued by an agreement state on which the physician's preceptor, Dr. B. Chandramouly, is specifically named as an authorized user;

NRC Form 313A (enclosed) may be used to document this information. Please note that if the board certification, or training and experience, was received more than 7 years ago, evidence of recentness of training in accordance with 10 CFR 35.59 must also be submitted.
