
In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 71.1 and 10 CFR 71.38, NAC International (NAC) hereby requests the timely renewal of U. S. NRC CoC No. 9010 for the Model No. NLI-1/2 (Package Identification No.: USA/9010/B()F), which will expire on April 30, 2006.

NAC has reviewed the current NLI-1/2 cask operating procedures (Section XV) in the NLI-1/2 Safety Analysis Report (SAR), May 1999 revision, and determined that no revisions to the SAR are required at this time. NAC has also reviewed the current NLI-1/2 maintenance program with the maintenance program (Section XVI) in the NLI-1/2 SAR, May 1999 revision, and found no revisions of the SAR to be necessary at this time.

NAC understands, unless an updated application demonstrating that the Model NLI-1/2 package design meets the current 10 CFR Part 71 requirements is submitted, CoC No. 9010 will expire on October 1, 2008, and cannot be renewed. NAC is currently evaluating possible future applications of the Model NLI-1/2 package. Should NAC decide to submit an updated application, the NRC will be notified in a timely manner prior to the submittal.
