SUBJECT: OFFICE CONCURRENCE ON PROPOSED RULEMAKING FOR
POWER REACTOR SECURITY REQUIREMENTS (WITS 200400178)

Your concurrence is requested on the attached proposed rulemaking package. This rulemaking package is being developed on an expedited schedule in accordance with the Commissions' schedule. As such, a prompt review is requested. My staff is available to meet and provide assistance, as required. We would like to receive comments as early as possible, and request your office concurrence by April 26, 2006, in order to meet the Commission's schedule.

Background:

The staff is proposing to amend its regulations that govern many of the requirements pertaining to security at power reactors and some requirements at Category I facilities. The proposed amendments would amend the NRC's regulations to, among other things, make generically applicable security requirements previously imposed by Commission orders issued after the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. Additionally, the proposed amendments would: (1) implement some provisions from the Energy Policy Act of 2005; (2) would implement explicit requirements to assess and manage site activities that can potentially have an adverse effect on safety and security; (3) and contain several new requirements that stem from the Commission's implementation of the security orders, revisions to the site security plans, and through lessons learned from force-on-force exercises.
